The Institute of Mathematics, Statistics and Scientific Computing (IMECC) at the University of Campinas (Unicamp) invites researchers in the Mathematical Sciences from countries involved in the conflict in Ukraine and other war-affected countries to apply for the **Researchers at Risk Initiative**, by the Sao Paulo Research Foundation (Fapesp):

The scheme will cover scientific stays for 12+ months at any university in the state of Sao Paulo, as well as travel costs, under the following modalities:

- -- **Visiting Researcher Award** (PV), granted initially for up to 12 months, which may be reevaluated and extended at Fapesp's discretion, under exceptional circumstances. Guidelines for the submission and selection of PV proposals are available at: https://fapesp.br/index.php/en/visiting
- -- **Post-Doctoral Fellowship** lasting up to 24 months, which may be extended. Guidelines for the submission and selection of Post-Doctoral Fellowships are available at: https://fapesp.br/en/postdoc

The call is currently open and applications will be processed as they are received, for expedited implementation, until the scheme's closure on **30 August 30th 2022**.

This is an equal opportunity call, and IMECC particularly welcomes applications from women and underrepresented groups in the Mathematical Sciences, regardless of religion, marital/maternity status, or migratory situation.
