

Prize of the Bulletin of the Brazilian Mathematical Society

The prize of the Bulletin of the Brazilian Mathematical Society (BMS) aims to distinguish the best original research article in Mathematics recently published in the Bulletin of the BMS. The judgment is based on the following parameters: originality, relevance, depth, and potential impact on the development of the respective field.

The prize of the BBMS will be awarded every two years, on the occasion of the Biennial Conference of the Brazilian Mathematical Society. Check it at <https://sbm.org.br/premio-bulletin/>.

Regulations of the Prize of the Bulletin of the BMS 2024

For the 2024 edition, the Prize of the BMS will adhere to the following rules:

1. The Prize comprises a diploma and a monetary award of \$1,000.00 (one thousand dollars). Recipients affiliated with a Brazilian university or educational institution will also be invited to deliver a plenary lecture at the Biennial of the BMS, with travel and accommodation expenses covered by the BMS. In cases of multiple co-authors, the monetary award will be divided equally among them. However, if multiple co-authors are affiliated with Brazilian universities or institutions, only the youngest co-author will receive the invitation to deliver the plenary lecture at the BMS Biennial conference.
2. The prize jury will consist of the following members: Professors Carolina Araujo, Lorenzo Diaz, Maria Aparecida Ruas, Eduardo Teixeira, Keti Tenenblat, Maria Eulalia Vares, José Felipe Voloch, with Daniel Pellegrino serving as the presiding member.
3. Articles published in the Bulletin of the BMS during 2023 or 2024 are eligible for nomination for the Prize.
 - 3.1. Articles that include members of the BMS Board of Directors among their authors are ineligible for nomination.
 - 3.2. Jury members are prohibited from participating in candidate evaluations when conflict of interests arise. Additionally, Article 5c) specifies the need to consider possible conflicts of interest when selecting reviewers. Such conflicts can occur if the jury member has collaborated with the candidate, is a faculty member in the same department, has supervised the candidate in any academic degree (including master's, doctoral, and postdoctoral supervision), or shares a close personal relationship with the candidate. will be reviewed by the judging committee prior to the commencement of the evaluation process.

- 3.3. To enhance representation in the field of mathematics, a special criterion will be implemented for women researchers who have experienced childbirth or adoption between 2020 and the year of their nomination for the prize. In such instances, articles published from 2022 onwards will be eligible for nomination. To qualify under this criterion, candidates must specify the dates of childbirth or adoption of their children at the time of nomination for the prize.
4. The Prize will be awarded to a maximum of one research article.
5. Nominations for the Prize are open to any researcher or faculty member affiliated with a national or international educational and research institution. The nomination package, which must be in English, should contain the following documents:
 - a) A concise declaration, not exceeding two pages, explaining the article (including complete reference) and providing justification for why the authors are being nominated for the Prize.
 - b) An electronic file of the article in .pdf format.
 - c) A recommendation letter from a minimum of two specialists in the candidate's field, either national or foreign. It is essential to ensure that the selected specialists do not pose a conflict of interest.
 - d) Information about each candidate, including their institution, email address, and either the URL of the Lattes curriculum or a PDF file containing the candidate's curriculum vitae.
6. Nominations, including all the required documentation listed above, should be emailed to secretaria@sbm.org.br with the subject line "Nomination for the BMS Prize" no later than May 10, 2024.
7. Self-nominations will not be accepted.
8. The recipient(s) of the Prize will be announced during the "SBM Biennial 2024" conference, where the award ceremony will also be held.
 - 8.1. The decision of the Jury is final and cannot be appealed.
9. The BMS Council of Directors retains the authority to address all ambiguous situations and deliberate on exceptional cases not explicitly covered by these regulations.
