

**RECIPROCITY MEMBERSHIP AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE EUROPEAN MATHEMATICAL SOCIETY (EMS) AND
THE BRAZILIAN MATHEMATICAL SOCIETY (BMS)**

The European Mathematical Society (EMS), represented by its President, Jan Philip Solovej and the Brazilian Mathematical Society (BMS), represented by the President, Jaqueline Godoy Mesquita share the common goal of promoting research and education in mathematical sciences. The two societies declare their intention to cooperate towards its accomplishment by exchanging and promoting information and by supporting their members in their professional development.

Article 1. Reciprocal Membership

I. For current European Mathematical Society members

An individual who is a member of the EMS at the time annual dues are paid is eligible for Reciprocal Membership of the BMS.

- Reciprocal membership dues: The annual fee for Reciprocal Members of the BMS will receive 50% discount in the regular fee of the membership.
- Reciprocal membership privileges: BMS Reciprocal Members are eligible for all privileges of a normal and individual member of the BMS. They are treated as normal and individual members of the BMS.

II. For current members of the Brazilian Mathematical Society

An individual who is a member of the BMS is eligible for Reciprocal Membership of the EMS.

- Reciprocal membership dues: The annual fee for Reciprocal Members of the EMS is defined in the EMS By-laws, section IV. Fees.
- Reciprocal membership privileges: EMS Reciprocal Members are eligible for all privileges of a normal, individual member of the EMS, except for mailing hardcopies of the EMS Magazine. This can be obtained for an additional annual fee set by the EMS Press publishing house.

Article 2. The EMS and the BMS will seek possibilities of holding common conferences and/or summer schools, alone or together with third parties.

Article 3. The editorial boards of both societies' quarterly publications, the EMS Newsletter and the BMS Newsletter, will be encouraged to exchange articles about topics of scientific interest as well as on the life of the society.

Article 4. The agreement is concluded for a four-year period. It will be renewed automatically unless one of the societies declares the intention to terminate it, giving one year's notice.
